The Universal Service Provision Fund (USPF) was established by the Federal Government of Nigeria to facilitate the achievement of national policy goals for universal access and universal service to Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in rural, un-served and under-served areas in Nigeria.

To achieve the above statutory mandate and in compliance with the provisions of the Public Procurement Act 2007, the Universal Service Provision Fund under its 2019 budget hereby invites qualified, competent and reputable contractors, consultants and service providers to submit Expression of Interest for Consultancies.

3. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

All submissions must comply with the requirements of Public Procurement Act, 2007 and interested bidders must submit the following documents:

a) Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation issued by Corporate Affairs Commission. Companies must enclose Certified True Copy (CTC) of the certificate of incorporation and form CAC 7 and CAC 2 (**Evidence of Registration of Business Name is acceptable for EA & FM**)

b) CTC of Articles and Memorandum of Association of the Company. It must show that the company is registered in part for the procurement;

c) Evidence of filing annual returns for the preceding three years by inclusion of an acknowledgement letter from Corporate Affairs Commission (2016, 2017, and 2018);

d) Tax Clearance Certificates for the preceding three years (2016, 2017, and 2018) valid till 31st of December 2019;

e) Evidence of current Pension Certificate valid till 31st December, 2019;

f) Evidence of current Industrial Training Fund (ITF) compliance certificate valid till 31st December, 2019:

g) Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2019;

h) Evidence of registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring by 31st January, 2020 or valid certificate issued by BPP;

i) Sworn Affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Universal Service Provision Fund or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and has to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars;

j) For EA & FM: Evidence of current registration with Financial Reporting Council of Nigeria;

k) Company's audited accounts for the last three years (2016, 2017 and 2018);

1) Evidence of financial capability to execute the project by submission of Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank in Nigeria, indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;

m) Documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar projects carried out in the past Five (5) years accompanied by Letters of Award, Job Completion Certificates and photographs of the projects;

n) Company's Profile with Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/Professional qualifications

- o) Evidence of Firm's registration with relevant professional body such as:
 - EA must be registered with Auditor-General's Office and Practice Licence;
 - IISED: Evidence of registration with NITDA and Computer Professionals Registration Council of Nigeria;

- TA: COREN, ARCON, CORBON, QSRBN etc;

- FM: ICAN/ANAN etc;.

For Joint Venture/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided (CAC, Tax Clearance Certificate, Pension Compliance Certificate, ITF Compliance Certificate, NSITF Compliance Certificate, IRR & Sworn Affidavit are compulsory for each JV partner). NOTE: NOT MORE THAN TWO COMPANIES SHOULD FORM A JOINT VENTURE

q) All documents for submission must be transmitted with a Covering/Forwarding letter under the Company/Firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), Contact Address, Telephone Number (preferably GSM No.), and e-mail address. The letterhead Paper must bear the names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page, duly signed by authorized officer of the firm.

4. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

i. Bids must be in English Language and signed by an official authorised by the bidder.

ii. Interested Firms are to submit two (2) bound Expression of Interest documents separately in a sealed envelope
